Winter Vegetable Ideas For Kids Lunch Boxes

- Avocado - on its own or made into a dip with celery or crackers
- Carrots – cut up into sticks, served with dip or salsa
- Celery – cut up into sticks either by themselves or with strips of cheese.
- Green beans – Trimmed.
- Snow peas – Trimmed.
- Apples (bonza, braeburn, fuji, gala, golden delicious, granny smith, jonagold, jonathan, lady williams, mutso, pink lady, red delicious, snow, sundowner) – As there are different varieties available include two apples in the lunch boxes. Eg, a pink lady and a granny smith.
- Kiwifruit (early winter) – cut this in half, wrap in plastic and include a spoon in the lunch box.
- Oranges (navel) – cut them into quarters and wrap in plastic.
- Pears (beurre bosc, josephine, packham in the early winter)
