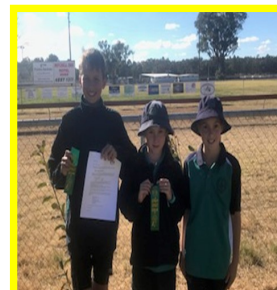


SPORT NEWS
