What is LOOP? - LOOP is Scholastic Book Clubs **L**inked **O**nline **O**rdering & **P**ayment platform for parents. Scholastic has introduced LOOP to make it easier for you. LOOP eliminates paper forms plus your online order is submitted to the school safe and sound. An App is also available to download on the app Store or you can get it on Google play.

How to Place an Order

- ◆ Sign in or register an account at: scholastic.com.au/loop
- ◆ Click on ORDER and select school and child's class
- ◆ Add child's first name and last initial (so the school knows who the book is for)
- ◆ Enter the product item number from the Book Club catalogue
- ◆ Make payment via credit card (cash facilities not available)
- ◆ All orders are attached to the school account until ready to be submitted to Scholastic by the school so there's no need to return orders or receipts to school

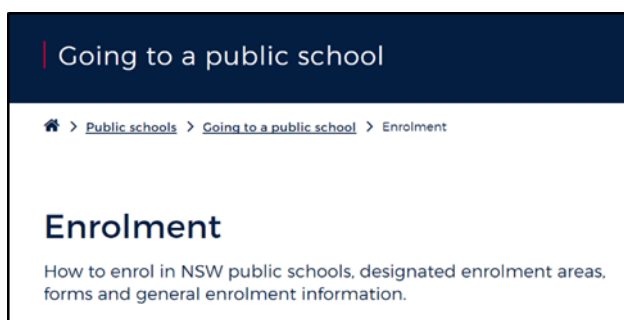
