From the Principal's Desk

- ◆ As the weather cools slightly we ask students be respectful of our **school uniform** and wear school jumpers.
- ◆ **Hoodies are not be worn to school.** This includes sporting jumpers. Hoods can be caught in play and result in injury.
- ◆ We look forward to seeing the many parents/carers who have booked a parent interview this Wednesday. Bookings are still open until Wednesday morning.
- ◆ Please consider your child **catching a bus home** of an afternoon. This would assist in traffic congestion. If you require more details please contact our front office as they can assist you.
- ◆ Last Friday all students participated in No Way to Bullying activities. Many discussions were held around the value of kindness and empathy for others.
- ◆ This week staff are holding a "**hat blitz**" where we are encouraging sun safety with all students.
- ◆ In the playground there has been a steady increase of **inappropriate language**. All students were spoken to at their respective assemblies last Friday and staff are closely monitoring. Many students report they hear "bad words" when they game and access online content. We ask you talk to your child about this issue. We explain it at school that teachers do not use these words and therefore they do not want to hear these words either.
- ◆ This Thursday we are celebrating Harmony Day. **Harmony Day** celebrates Australia's cultural diversity and occurs on 21 March each year and coincides with the United Nations' International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination. Students are invited to come dressed in orange or yellow out of uniform and bring a \$2 donation.
- ◆ If your child is in the community outside school hours and they are wearing our uniform, please be mindful their behaviour is still representing our school.
- ◆ Thank you to all those families who have so far donated to our **annual Easter egg raffle**. Any Easter goodies may be dropped at either the office or with class teachers.
