Bus Lines



Respect

- Listen to the teachers
- Listen to the bus driver

Responsibility

- Stay in your correct bus line
- Make sure your bag is packed and zipped up
- Know what bus you are catching
- Bus 3 and 4, Year 3 - Year 6 students can walk to the bus if the bell has gone.
- Other buses Kindy - Year 6 are to line up in the bus line

Safety

- Stay in bus lines until told to move by a teacher
- Long bus students to sit down near the chair until teacher says its okay to move
- Walk to the bus
- Do not walk outside the school to the bus without teacher permission
