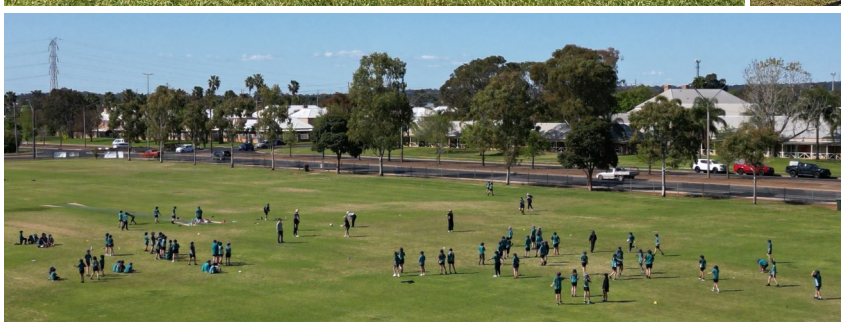

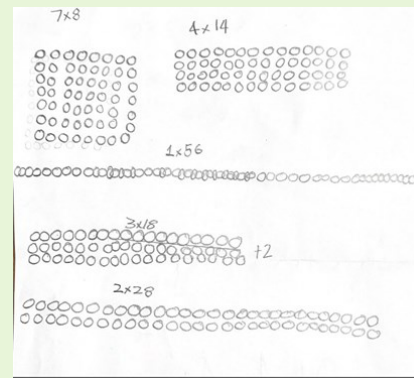
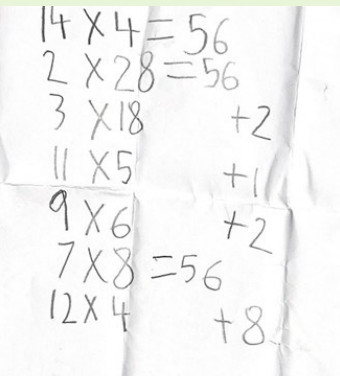
Last Tuesday afternoon, the whole school participated in a games afternoon, competing against staff in some games.

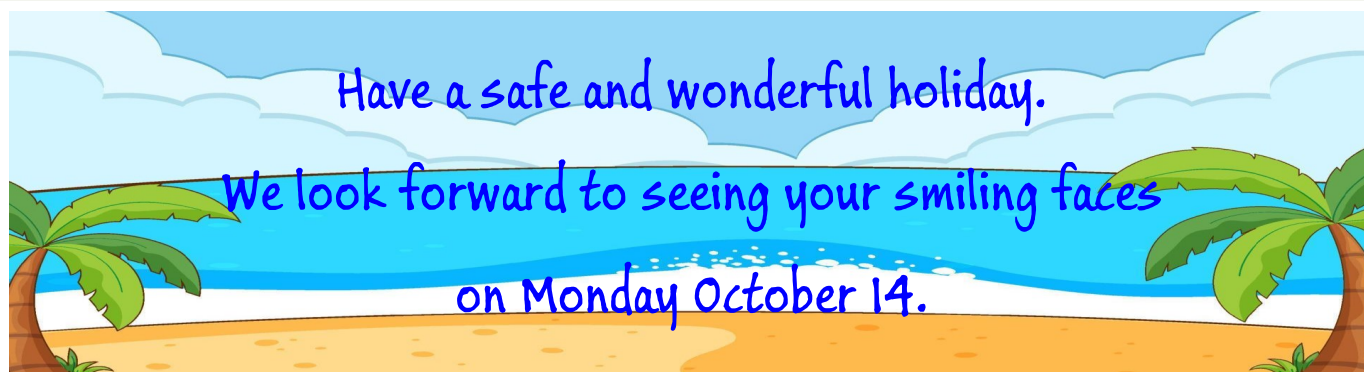
